Health and Safety Precautions Camp Sites

Fires Free standing fireplaces are provided for each campsite. They are stored by the barns and must be returned after use. Care should be taken as to where they are sited. Pallets, fire extinguishers, fire blankets fire point stakes, sand and water buckets have been left in the small barn for your use. Please return them after use. Fire Point pallets must not be burned. If you use a fire extinguisher please inform the warden and leave it apart from the others.

The campfire at the top of site 2 is for the use of all campers.

Fires should be supervised at all times. After use, see that the fire is extinguished before retiring.

Woodpile Caution should be taken as wood may contain thorns, nails etc. Wood may be cut in this area, but should be supervised by an adult.

Woods The wooded area at the top of campsite 2 is for the use of groups, but young people should be supervised. Do not climb over fences as these are topped with barbed wire. Use the stiles. Please do not swing on gates as this causes them to 'drop'. Any gates tied up with rope are not to be used. Care should be taken by the stream and boggy areas. Adult supervision is recommended

Personal Safety Please be aware of the Public Footpath which runs through the grounds alongside the fence between the Centre and campsite 3.

No child should leave the property unsupervised

Freezer and Fridge We recommend that these are used only by adults and cleaned out but left switched on at the end of your stay.

Camp Site Taps. Our water is metered, so please bear this in mind and take care not to flood the area beneath the taps.

Rubbish The black bin is for your use. Please only put bagged items in it and empty it into the red bin near the main gates, then return it to the barn.

Personal Standards Leaders should ensure that all campers wash their hands before preparing food and eating.

Preparation of food and the use of the kitchen area should be supervised by an adult.

Every effort should be made to ensure that there is no consumption of alcohol by under age young people.

Young people should not leave the site without supervision.

Group Standards Before departure, groups are expected to clean the toilet block. The site should be left tidy and any equipment returned to its proper place. Please bag all your refuse and put into the large green bin in the car park.

Dogs are not permitted anywhere on the Camp sites, or the Centre with the exception of Guide dogs. This is because of the risk to young people of toxocara canis.
